I have recently visited Amsterdam and came across a point some of your readers might consider useful. The public transport system in the Netherlands has introduced a new method of ticketing called the OV Chipkaart. You have to purchase a card for 3 euro and then put money on the card and this enables you to travel based on milage rather than zones. I loaded my card with 40 euros and within 3 days and 6.66 euro travel I was refused entry to a Metro because my balance was too low. My balance was 0.04 euros. I made efforts to get the balance corrected but was met with rude and unfriendly client services, maybe because I do speak Dutch, and they thought I was a local rather than a tourist. I loaded some more money on the card and continued further then I found I had been charged the maxium route fare 3 times although I had only traveled a very short distance. I attempted to get the balance that was on the card reimbursed upon leaving the Netherlands but was told that this was not possible I was also informed that I would be unable to use the balance if I returned after the expiry date on the card.
