We purchased a 60 day Discovery Pass through Greyhound and supplemented this at the end with individual bus tickets. There are some things to note about these passes. Firstly, on the internet the 60 day pass is priced at C\$750 if purchased in Canada or US\$750 if purchased in the USA, so obviously the former is cheaper. However, if buying at a Greyhound station the 60 day pass only cost C\$499 plus tax, making a total of \$523. There is no seniors discount on this pass. The 15 day pass costs \$299 plus tax, a total of \$315, and the 30 day pass is in between. It is much more expensive to buy the pass before leaving Australia from an Australian Agent. Identification is required to purchase the pass but a passport is sufficient.
