In May of this year I visited the county Donegal in Ireland. I would like to inform you that Dunlewy Lakeside Hostel has closed his doors about 3 years ago as I was told by a local Irishman.

The North Donegal Horn Head walk, which we attempted on Sunday August 16 2009. We would respectfully suggest that it is no longer accurate to describe the walk as a counter-clockwise loop around the head. The southeastern section of the walk is severely overgrown with 5ft high bracken and thorns, and there is frequently no sign of a trail. Not only is this section of the trail hard slogging it is very dangerous in places -- especially as the bracken conceals cliff edges in places, and the footing is very unstable. We are experienced, fit and well equipped trail walkers and it took close to 4 hours to navigate the first third of the walk as it is described in the book. We met others who either abandoned the walk and turned back, or exited at the ruins of the small settlement. I would recommend that the walk be revisited by your staff and the description adjusted to ensure that others do not unwittingly find themselves in difficulty or danger. It may be better to suggest walking up along the eastern branch of Horn Head Drive, and then staying on the road up to the Coast Guard Station to eventually join with the trail at the Sig
